

INSTRUCTIONS FOR BASIC BIB



Hi there! This tutorial is for a basic bib for babies. We used two different colored t-shirts since it is reversible. We also encourage creativity with these bibs, so we made our bib look like a little animal. We hope you enjoy it!

PIN, TRACE & CUT PATTERN ON 2 LAYERS



1. Use the pattern provided for you on our website and cut two layers. We used one red t-shirt and one blue t-shirt to make the two layers.

PREPARE CORDS

2. Cut two half an inch, or 1.3 cm, wide strips and pull to make them strings. The cords needs to be approximately 5 inches, or 13 cm, long.

SANDWICH CORDS

3. Place the cords in between the two layers, "sandwiching" the cord. The cords should be inside the two layers, unseen.

4. The cords will be placed on the edge of the pattern where you would tie the bib around the baby's neck.

5. Leave the cords inside and make sure that they don't touch the other edges of the pattern, you don't want to sew over them.

MAKE SURE THE CORDS IS IN BETWEEN 2 LAYERS

6. You are going to sew all around the bib, but we're going to make sure that the cords are inside. That they're sandwiched in, in-between the two fabrics.

PIN CORDS

7. You can put pins right on top of the cords to make sure they don't move.

LEAVE AN OPENING WHEN MARKING

8. Now what we are going to do is sew around the bib at quarter of an inch, or 0.6 cm, away from the edges.

9. Starting at the bottom of the bib is the best.

10. You will leave an opening to be able to turn the bib inside out. We are going to start sewing at the opening at the bottom.

MAKE SURE TO REVERSE!

11. Remember to reverse!

CUT SLITS CAREFULLY

12. You must cut little slits on the curves of the bib to make sure they can move properly as the bib is worn.

13. Remember, cut very carefully, so you don't cut the stitch you just sewed by mistake.

TURN INSIDE OUT

14. Turn the bib inside out using the opening!

SEW TOPSTITCH TO CLOSE THE OPENING

15. Sew a topstitch on the edge of the bib to close the opening of where we turned the bib inside out.

16. With the topstitch, you can either sew all the way around the bib or stop when you close the opening.

DECORATE IT THE WAY YOU LIKE!

17. You can draw on the bib, do whatever you want, use your imagination.

18. You can also cut pieces of other t-shirt fabrics and create a pattern and glue it on.
